## **WORKSHOPS**

### National Animal Identification System

Dr. Boyd Parr, Dr. Mike Martin, and Dr. Julie Helm from Clemson University LPH will present an overview of the National Animal Identification System (NAIS) currently being implemented by USDA APHIS VS. Topics will include the current status of premises identification (PIN), animal identification (AIN & GIN), and animal movement tracking. Additionally participants will hear about opportunities in management and marketing that relate to NAIS. Questions will be welcomed.

### Avian Influenza: Separating Fact From Fiction

Dr. Julie Helm, Dr. Mike Martin, and Dr. Boyd Parr from Clemson University LPH will present the latest information concerning the outbreak of avian influenza in Asia currently in the daily headlines. Topics will include basic information about avian influenza including diagnosis, surveillance, and control in SC and the U.S. This seminar is designed to help participants separate out hype from facts surrounding avian influenza and also realize what the actual risk is of Asian Bird Flu entering the U.S.

Amanda McNulty from Clemson University will present a hands-on demonstration in making inexpensive decorative arrangements for the home using fruit and vegetables. Participants will have the opportunity to not only observe but also to participate in making arrangements.
